Ottawa's Knox Church is seeking a new Minister to inspire, support, guide and grow our congregation.

We seek a Minister who is Christ-centered, who will maintain a high standard of preaching and prayer, and who will celebrate and build upon the community of Knox. The Minister we call to Knox will have the leadership abilities necessary to deal creatively with current and future challenges, will possess team-building, communications and people skills and have proven Christian education and pastoral care experience. We seek a person prepared to make a long-term commitment to Knox.

Established in 1844, Knox houses Ottawa's second oldest Presbyterian congregation. Our imposing, stone Gothic building with its magnificent stained glass windows was built in 1932. It is located only six blocks south of the National War Memorial and Parliament Hill and is across the street from the Law Courts and City Hall. The congregation rejoices in its fine building, long tradition of good preaching, excellent music and dedication to community service. At present, the congregation consists of about 282 members, 90 adherents and 19 children.

While our search is focused in Canada, we will consider candidates from the United States and internationally. Couples serving in a shared (team) ministry are welcome to apply. We offer a competitive stipend and housing, mileage and study leave allowances. The amount of the compensation package will depend on education and experience.
